

2017 Scholarship Application Process and Requirements

Application Deadline: April 28, 2017

Students applying for a scholarship from The Transportation Club of Houston (TCH) and TCH members sponsoring students must meet all of the following requirements.

Sponsorship

- All scholarship applicants must be sponsored by a TCH member in good standing in conjunction with a school faculty member.
- TCH members can sponsor no more than two applicants, including themselves.
- Members of the Education/Scholarship Committee cannot sponsor an applicant.

Application and Transcript requirements

- Scholarship applicants will forward a completed TCH Scholarship Application with a certified copy of their most recent transcript and essay to the address indicated below. Copies of transcripts are not acceptable. Digital essays will be acceptable.
- Applicants must be available to the TCH Education/Scholarship Committee for an interview, as needed. (phone call)
- All applications, essays and transcripts must be received no later than <u>April 28, 2017</u>. By applying, applicants authorize TCH to verify all data on the scholarship application.

Scholarship Terms and Limitations

- TCH Scholarships may be awarded on an annual basis. The total amount of scholarship funds for distribution will be determined by recommendation of the Education/Scholarship Committee to the Board of Governors.
- Full -time and Part-time students are eligible to participate in the scholarship program at the start of the second semester level of their freshman year. Students can participate for a maximum of four years and must apply every year to participate. See criteria for former winners.
- One or more TCH scholarships may be awarded to students in transportation and related fields
 of supply chain, warehousing, and international business logistics.



Criteria for former scholarship winners

 Before applying for a second or subsequent scholarship, applicant must demonstrate involvement in club activities. The Student Committee of TCH is designed to assist in continued participation, as a volunteer or committee member. Student participation at regular TCH programs or activities must also be demonstrated.

Scholarship Awarded

- TCH scholarships vary in amounts, based on funds available. Scholarships will be awarded at the TCH Annual Dinner, tentatively scheduled for <u>June 2017</u>.
- Candidates must be present at the Annual Dinner to receive the scholarship, unless prior approval by the Education/Scholarship Committee and the Board of Governors is granted.
- Scholarship funds are directly sent to your college/university. Accurate mailing information and name of contact person is critical on the application.

Essay Topic

The essay must be a minimum of 500 words. It must be double-spaced and include supporting references in MLA format. Digital media will be accepted for the essay (i.e. power point, etc.).

Transportation Infrastructure; what are the key issues and solutions for repairing/maintaining, improving/enhancing and funding our national transportation infrastructure over the next decade? The essay should address the following three points:

- a. What area of transportation infrastructure investment (highways, seaports, rail, or airports) would generate the greatest economic benefit, and why?
- b. What would be the best method for funding these infrastructure projects?
- c. How would technology innovations influence infrastructure design and investment for all modes of transportation?
